Secretary Report

Kelly Lange read the Secretary Report. The November minutes are out on the website. There will be no PTO News this month and we are up to 360 email contacts.

Old Business:

At the November PTO meeting we voted to not donate to Sustainable Energy. If anyone wants to support it or would be interested in any information on it we are able to provide that for you. The teacher conference meal in November was successful as well as movie night in December. There were over 180 people in attendance and we showed the movie Inside Out. The next movie night will be Friday, February 26<sup>th</sup>.

New Business:

We are searching for new Board members for the 2016-2017 school year. Nikki Sidles position as co-chair, as well as Kelly Dolan Lange position as Secretary is up this year. The terms begin in August 2016 and will be 2-year terms. We will vote at the April PTO meeting. If anyone is interested or knows of anyone that is interested please contact one of the board members.

The PTO will provide crayons and coloring books again this year for Kindergarten Round up. We also have been asked to make a dessert for the Mustang Foundation event on January 23, 2016. We will also need someone to serve it as well. Virginia Lake volunteered to represent the PTO.

### Fund Requests

Dewey Hupke spoke requesting funds for the Old Creamery Theater. The event will be March 14, 2016 and the total amount requested is \$625.00. This money will cover students from Kindergarten through 5<sup>th</sup> grade. The Old Creamery chronicles the 6 pillars of good character focusing on Journey of life and focuses on what kind of person do you want to be? This was voted on via paper ballot and was approved unanimously.

The next fund request came from Mrs. Flickinger who was speaking on behalf of Mrs. Kelly Mitchell. She reported that they are having trouble with the headphones in their classrooms and they recently found some that work. They are asking for 12 pairs of headphones per classroom and there are 5 classrooms. Total with tax will be \$384.56. This was voted on via paper ballot and was approved unanimously.

The final fund request was from Brittany Holt in the Junior Kindergarten. She is looking for some items to use during the students centers time. She is requesting a Classic Hardwood Train Set (69.99), Indestructible Kitchen Set for 4 (19.99), Best Buy Play Food Assortment (\$49.99) and Doctors Office (29.99). The total with shipping is \$195.41. This was voted on via paper ballot and approved unanimously.

### Carnival Committee:

At this time the Carnival Committee's biggest need is for volunteers to sign up for committees. These committees include Games, Food, and Silent Auction. We are not doing a raffle this year at the carnival.

The silent auction will include baskets made by classroom teachers and principals. We will put a minimum bid on each basket and ask that the teachers have an itemized list of what is in the basket. The PTO will do a basket with an Independence or Mustang theme. We are asking the specials teachers to provide baked goods or books unless they wish to do a basket as well. Some of the PTO board will go speak with teachers on Professional Development day about their ideas for the Silent Auction. We will need 3 volunteers to help with the Silent Auction.

The Food Committee needs 3 people to help with the food. At the last carnival the PTO served cotton candy, popcorn, candy, bottled water, and juice boxes and members donated bars to sell. We will be doing all tickets this year, so food will be purchased with tickets.

The Games committee needs about 10 people to help with games and to assist in deciding which games will be played. If we do not reach our maximum number of committee members by January 27<sup>th</sup> we will consider not having the carnival this spring.
